**Woodstock Fair Theme:**

## Rules and Regulations:

- Entry forms must be completed. Entries and fee may accompany you at the door on Thursday August 24, 2023, between 8-11am. ENTRY FEES AT THE DOOR APPLY TO THESE 4-H ENTRY CLASSES ONLY!!!!
- Exhibitors will be required to pay a fee of \$5.00 and can enter as many classes as they wish. Exhibitors must be current paid youth participants of Oxford County 4-H for 2023.
- Each Exhibitor will be limited to one entry in each class.
- Exhibitors will exhibit their own projects according to the 4-H Motto “LEARN TO DO BY DOING”. Item must be made by the 4-H youth participant only.
- If there are more than 6 entries in the class it will be split into Clover Buds (6-8), Jr. (9-14) and Sr. (15-21), with the exception of the 4-H Exhibits and the Special Class, which will be judged as an entire class with no divisions.
- Exhibits must be worthy to be awarded prize money at the discretion of the judge.
- Entries must be at the fairgrounds between 8am and 11am Thursday August 24, 2023, and must be removed between 2:00pm and 8:00pm on Monday August 28, 2023.



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## Oxford County 4-H Association Special Class

Create an outdoor/nature scene using any medium, no larger than half sheet of Bristol board. Example—natural items, building blocks, play dough, drawing, poster. Be Creative!!

**Prize money: 1<sup>st</sup> - \$15.00 2<sup>nd</sup> - \$12.00**  
**3<sup>rd</sup> - \$10.00 4<sup>th</sup> - \$8.00**  
**5<sup>th</sup> - \$5.00**  
**All remaining entries - \$3.00**

**4-H Exhibits** (Not previously exhibited, limit of one per project per club or opportunity) These 3-sided display board exhibits are to depict club activities, projects or opportunities (e.g. Discovery Days, Youth Adventure Camp, Future Leaders in Action, Provincial Leadership Camp, GFTG)

**All remaining entries - \$10**

## **Class #3**

**In celebration of 4-H Canada's 110th year**, something you have learned by using the 4-H Motto "Learn to do by Doing". Examples—poster, report, craft

## **Class #4**

**Animal Care Poster**, using a full sheet of Bristol board, outline how to care for an animal, including housing, nutrition, health, etc.

## **Class #5**

**Four (4) Photos promoting Fair theme "Back to Our Roots"**, each picture size 4" x 6", mounted together on one black background, minimum border to be 2 cm. Pictures must be taken by exhibitor. No words or captions.

## **Class #6**

**Handmade Craft**, any handmade item made by exhibitor, examples—sewing, woodworking, knitting, crocheting etc., not previously shown at fair.

## **Class #7**

**Paper Craft**, using any paper medium made by exhibitor, examples—scrapbook page, origami, puppet, card, napkin folding

## **Class #8**

**Recycled/re-purposed craft**, item made from recycled/re-purposed materials, handmade by exhibitor, not previously shown at fair.

## **Class #9**

**Original Food Dish**, showcase an original recipe created by you, with ingredient list and preparation method, a photo of the finished dish, and comments from at least two people who ate it.

## **Class #10**

**Cow Chip Cookies** (Clover Bud Program Year Two 4-H project), one Cookie on a disposable plate in a Ziploc bag, Cookies of two different entrants must not be taken from the same batch. This is the full recipe but can be made into smaller batches.

250mL (1 cup) butter

250mL (1cup) shortening

500mL (2cups) brown sugar

4 eggs

10mL (2 tsp.) vanilla

1000mL (4 cups) flour

10mL (2 tsp.) baking soda

10mL (2 tsp.) baking powder

500mL (2 cups) oatmeal

500mL (2 cups) cornflakes

170g package (6 oz.) chocolate chips

Preheat oven to 175 degrees Celsius (350-degree F)

Cream butter, shortening and brown sugar. Add eggs and vanilla. Add flour, baking soda and baking powder. Stir in oatmeal, corn flakes, chocolate chips. Put on greased cookie sheet with an ice cream scoop. Bake for 10-12 minutes. These are chewy cookies!
